A RULE TO REMEMBER

IMPROPER DELIVERY OF THE JACK

The Jack has been improperly delivered if it comes to rest

- in the ditch
- completely outside the boundaries of the rink
- at a distance of less than 23 metres measured in a straight line from the front of the mat to the nearest point of the jack after the jack has been centred.
