Note 1: Coloured shirt refers to the approved Begbrook Club top for ladies and men.

Note 2: Members can wear a white pullover or cardigan over the shirt, along with the green fleece or white (hooded) waterproof tops and bottoms, when circumstances permit.

Note 3: Coloured shirts can be worn for external Cup Competitions (County) so long as when playing pairs, triples and fours all team members wear them.
