Club Dress Code

Members are required to **comply** with the dress code (see below) at all times when on the bowling green, including wearing the correct bowling shoes (that is flat soled shoes).

#Shorts when worn are to be either GBA/BE approved or tailored shorts with belted waist and approximately knee length. Beige/fawn coloured, cargo type shorts or football/rugby type shorts are unacceptable. Socks, if worn with shorts, should be plain white or grey.

Note 1: Coloured Club shirt refers to the approved Begbrook Club top for both ladies and men.

Note 2: Members can wear a white pullover or cardigan over the shirt, along with the green fleece or white (hooded) waterproof tops and bottoms, when circumstances permit.

Note 3: Dress code rules for League & County matches will take precedence.

Note 4: The dress code does not apply to **casual roll ups** except Club night but members are required to wear approved bowling footwear whilst on the green.
